



He is the one who creates everything.


He loves us.


He wants us to love him.

with his death.


He has created the Church.

THE HOLY SPIRIT


- It's invisible.

Gospel John 14, 25-26:

"I have told you all these things while I was still with you, but the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have told you . "

Nouns: defender, advocate, protector, comforter.

Pentecost



- ✓ Jesus promised that he would send the Holy Spirit.
- ✓ The promise was fulfilled in a most manifest way on the day of Pentecost.
- ✓ Resurrection of Jesus.
- ✓ Period of the apparitions. About 40 days (Luke).
- ✓ End of the apparitions: the Ascension.
- ✓ Feast of Pentecost: episode of the outpouring of the Spirit.


Columbus
